



Student Departures

At the end of their time studying in Delta, and staying with you, students will prepare to fly back home to their natural parents. Before the trip to the airport and saying goodbye, there are a few things to consider. This document is to help remind everyone of those extra details.

While packing up, your student may notice that they have done a lot of shopping during their time in Canada. They might need you to help them go and get an additional suitcase in order to pack all of their things. They may also need to check with their air carrier to see about additional luggage costs.

Students are expected to leave their bedroom clean and tidy. With your help and direction, all of their personal belongings and garbage should be removed and all school textbooks and library books should have been returned. Please do a quick final check to ensure that nothing has been forgotten.

Airport drop off is one of the listed duties when you agree to become a homestay parent. It is a nice way to have closure on the relationship when they leave as well.

Drive your student to the airport, arriving three hours prior to scheduled departure times for international flights and two hours prior to scheduled departure times for domestic flights.

Please walk your student into the airport, help them if they need assistance, and wait while the student completes the baggage check. Walk with them over to the security check area and watch them go through after saying your goodbyes.

Please also review connection procedures if the student is changing planes along the route.

TIP

You may wish to park your car at the River Rock parking facility and use the sky train to see your student off. This will reduce the cost to you.
